# QuarkXPress 5.0

QuarkXPress™ is powerful page layout software with an intuitive, versatile interface that lets you combine writing, editing, and typography with color and pictures to produce dynamic final output. QuarkXPress Passport™ has all the features and capabilities of QuarkXPress, with the added ability to handle multiple-language documents, making your international publishing easier and more efficient.

## QuarkXPress and QuarkXPress Passport 5.0

QuarkXPress and QuarkXPress Passport 5.0 still have the same great layout, typographic, and long-document features of earlier versions, with improved speed and performance. New features in QuarkXPress include the ability to create tables, layers, and Web documents with a comprehensive range of Web features. Enhancements have also been made to printing, text, and long-document publishing features.

### Create Web documents

QuarkXPress allows you to create Web documents. Because Web documents can contain features such as rollovers, hyperlinks, and forms, you can easily create Web documents that meet a wide variety of requirements. Web documents created with QuarkXPress 5.0 can be exported as HTML documents; the exported documents can be posted directly on a Web site.

Because exported Web documents conform to open standards, they can be opened and edited in standards-based tools such as Dreamweaver. This means you are not locked into one proprietary format; the exported HTML from QuarkXPress Web documents can be used by anyone in your Web workflow, even if they are using a different HTML editing tool.

### Repurpose content

To create a Web document from a print document, or vice versa, you must move or copy the content from one type of document to the other. Since print and Web documents reflect different publishing environments, you may need to refine your content after moving it. However, in most cases, you won't need to modify the content, and moving or copying content between documents is quick and easy.

### Create XML content

Avenue.quark™ software is included with QuarkXPress 5.0 to give you another convenient and intuitive means of creating and storing media-independent content. Using avenue.quark software, you can automate the process of extracting content from QuarkXPress documents; extracted content can then be stored in Extensible Markup Language (XML) format. XML content can then be used with HTML templates to create dynamic Web pages.

Using avenue.quark, you can also automatically place XML content in a QuarkXPress document for print, HTML, or PDF output.

### Isolate and arrange items using layers

The layers feature of QuarkXPress offers you greater flexibility in creating documents. Layers are “tiers” of QuarkXPress documents that allow you to isolate items. For example, if you have items that need to be in a document but should not print, such as job numbers or output instructions, you can place them on a hidden layer. You can also use layers to create different language versions of the same document.

### Quickly create tables

QuarkXPress allows you to create tables that organize data into rows and columns. Because tables can include pictures, they are very versatile. You can use tables to organize financial data, arrange thumbnail views of pictures, or combine pictures and text. You can save text from tables or turn tabbed text into tables. With so many options, incorporating tables into QuarkXPress documents is fast and easy.

### Enhanced printing features

QuarkXPress lets you print blank plates when printing separations, and provides a more comprehensive Preview tab in the Print dialog box.

Additionally, significant enhancements have been made to non-PostScript printing, including the ability to print thumbnails, print rotated TIFF pictures at full resolution, send composite RGB output to a non-PostScript printer. You can also use the Page Positioning, Fit in Print Area, and Frequency settings with non-PostScript printers, and use print styles with a non-PostScript printer.

### Improved long-document publishing features

In QuarkXPress 5.0, the Index palette now allows you to add all occurrences of a word to your index, and to add words in reverse order. For example, you can add all occurrences of Doe, Jane. This feature is useful when creating documents such as yearbooks or company directories.

You can also change an index entry's level using the Edit button in the Index palette, and specify a default character style sheet for cross-references.

In addition to several improvements to the **Book** feature, you can also specify character sheets when defining a list, making the **List** feature more versatile and powerful.

#### **Backwards compatibility and downsaving**

QuarkXPress 5.0 will open 3.3x and 4.x documents. You can save a QuarkXPress 5.0 document in 4.x format; some 5.0 features may not be retained, or may be modified, when you do so. You can use the **Append** feature to add specific elements, such as colors and style sheets, of QuarkXPress 4.x documents to QuarkXPress 5.0 documents.

Additionally, almost all existing 4.x QuarkXTensions™ modules will work with QuarkXPress 5.0. Quark has sent XTensions™ developers the information they need to update their XTensions software and take advantage of all the new QuarkXPress 5.0 features. If you need to know if a specific XTensions module will work with QuarkXPress 5.0, please contact the developer or an XTensions software distributor.

#### **Manage multiple Quark products**

Quark License Administrator software is a license management tool that allows you to easily manage licensed Quark products, such as QuarkXPress software, on multiple computers. Quark License Administrator lets you assign licenses to individuals or groups and use auxiliary licenses. (When you purchase QuarkXPress 5.0, you request the ability to use auxiliary licenses. If you have already purchased QuarkXPress 5.0 but did not choose to receive auxiliary licenses at that time, you can obtain auxiliary licenses by contacting Quark.)
